- New Exhibitors (someone who has not entered any Homecraft Class in the last 5 years) MUST mark entry tag with NE to qualify for Special Prize.
- All potted plants and cut flowers competing for prizes MUST be grown by Exhibitor.
- Purchased Flowers may be used ONLY for "ARRANGEMENTS"
- All pots and plants are to be cleaned and prepared for judging.
- We are not responsible for any breakage or loss of containers, etc.
- Entries must be physically in by 11:30 AM on Friday.
- All potted plants and show pieces MUST be contained in a pot not exceeding 10" in any direction, including the rim (top diameter, bottom diameter & pot height) unless otherwise stated (i.e. #6 & #7).
- Geranium & Foliage entries are to have been started this year.

#### **POTTED PLANTS:**

**PRIZES:** 1st \$7, 2nd \$6, 3rd \$4

All potted plants and show pieces MUST be contained in a pot not exceeding 10" in any direction, including the rim (top diameter, bottom diameter & pot height) unless otherwise stated (i.e. #6 & #7). Geranium & Foliage entries to have been started this year.

1. One Geranium in bloom, any colour
2. One Flowering Begonia, double
3. One Flowering Begonia, single
4. One Flowering Mum, any size, any colour
5. Collection of Coleus in planter, at least three
6. Hanging Impatiens plant, pots up to 14" (including rim)
7. Hanging Fuschia plant, pots up to 14" (including rim)
8. Cactus display planted in one container, cacti and/or succulent
9. Fern
10. Most unusual flowering plant (name of plant on tag)
11. Aloe Vera
12. African Violet, single bloom, single crown, any colour
13. African Violet, double bloom, single crown, any colour
14. African Violet, miniature, single crown, double or single bloom, any colour
15. Collection of herbs, at least 3, named, in single pot
16. Baby Tears
17. Christmas Cactus
18. Any other house plant

#### **CUT FLOWERS:**

- 23. Gladiolus, 1 spike
- 24. Asters, 3 stems
- 25. Snapdragons, 3 stems
- 26. Bachelor Buttons, 3 stems
- 27. Pansies, 3 blooms
- 28. Zinnias, 3 blooms 2" and under

29. Zinnias, 3 blooms over 2"
30. Cosmos, 3 blooms
31. Marigold, 3 blooms 2" and under
32. Marigold, 3 blooms over 2"
33. Miniature rose, 1 bloom, own foliage
34. Miniature rose, 1 spray, own foliage
35. Rose (any other variety), 1 bloom, own foliage
36. Petunias, 3 single
37. Petunias, 3 double
38. Calendulas, 3 blooms
- 39 Large Sunflower Head
40. Dwarf sunflowers (diameter of 6 in. or less), 3 blooms
41. Floating Fantasy
42. Sedum, Autumn Joy, 3 stems
43. Sedum, any other variety (ie. BlackJack, Cloud Nine, Dragon's Blood, Ground Clover etc.) 3 stems
44. Collection of cut flowers, at least 3 varieties and 2 of each specimen

#### **ARRANGEMENTS:**

**PRIZES:** 1st \$8; 2nd \$7; 3rd \$5

- Please note that arrangements & specials are not to exceed 10" in any direction unless otherwise stated.
- Entries MUST NOT contain artificial flowers. Decorations may be used as embellishments but not as main element of arrangement.
- 45. "POT ET FLEUR": Collection of house plants (minimum 3) and cut flowers in planter
- 46. "GO NUTS!": Arrangement using flowers, foliage, nuts and pinecones
- 47. "THANKSGIVING": Arrangement in a small pumpkin, squash or gourd
- 48. "ALL HANDS ON DECK": Arrangement featuring playing cards.
- 49. "WILD BEAUTY": Wildflowers & Fall Foliage in an old container. Not to exceed 18" in height.
- 50. "CRANK UP THE COLOUR": An arrangement using lots of colour. Use of food colouring is allowed.
- 51. "NEW ARRIVAL": Arrangement to celebrate baby arrival. Accessories optional.
- 52. "QUILT BLOCK": Cut flowers in an arrangement in an 8" cake pan.
- 53. "FIRST FROST": A design using white flowers & to include trailing greenery (other greenery may be added as well)
- 54. "TOASTING A CELEBRATION": Arrangement in a stemmed glass.

55. "TRADITIONAL COUNTRY GARDEN": Design not to exceed 15" in height. **PRIZES:** 1st \$12; 2nd \$8; 3rd \$5, Donated by the Hendren Funeral Homes
